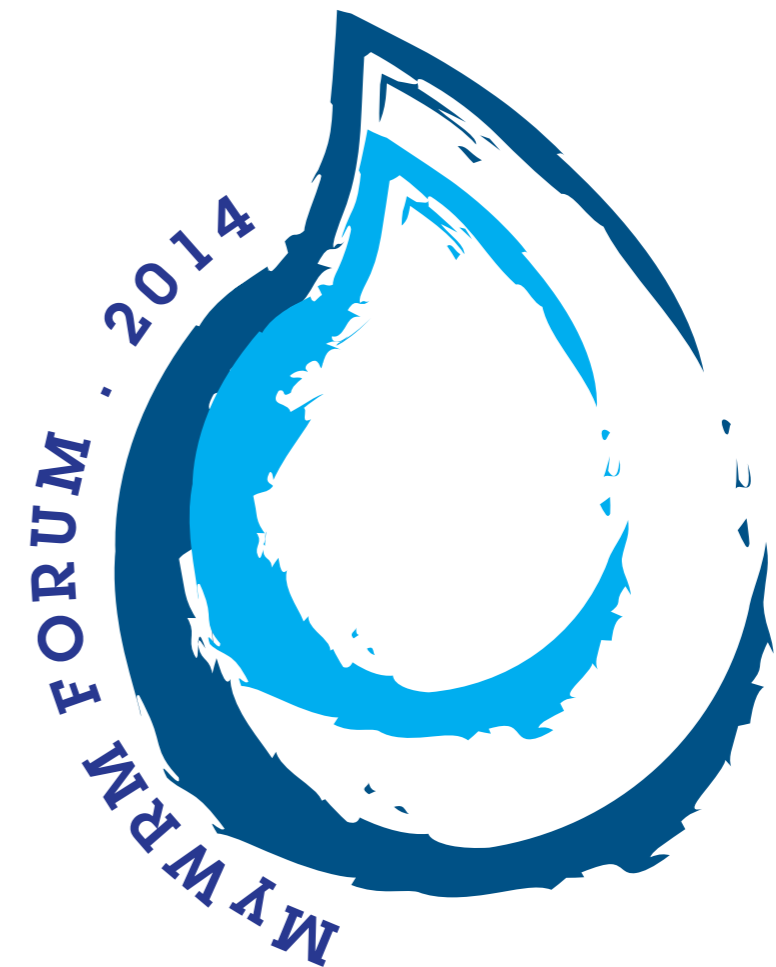

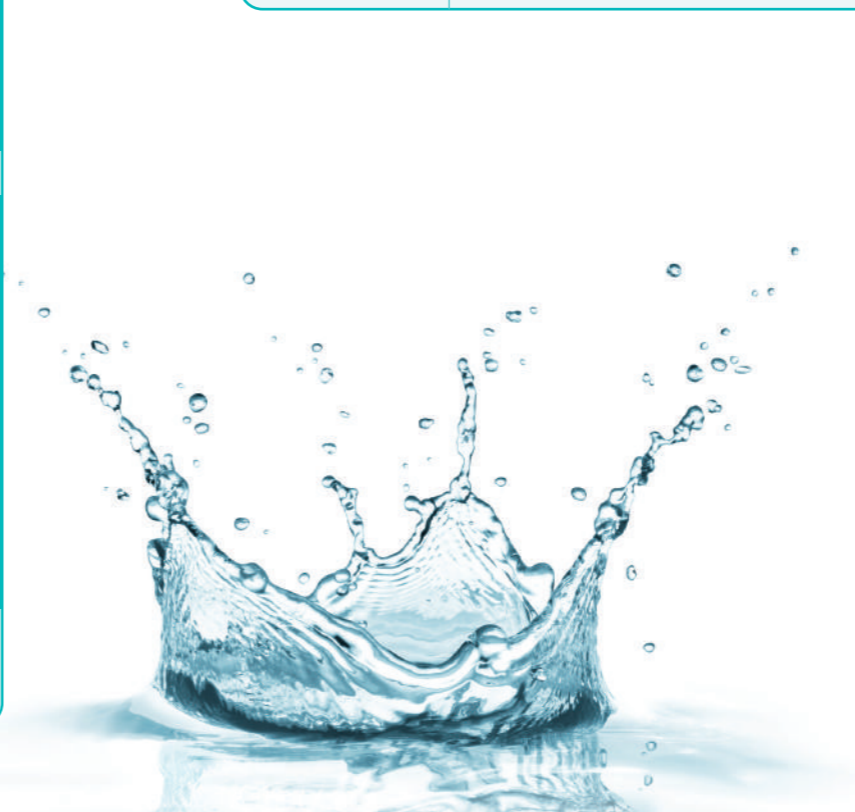
## Objectives of Forum
